

How to complain about a Parish Councillor

For the purposes of the Code of Conduct, Kirkburton Parish Council comes under the jurisdiction of Kirklees. If you feel that a Parish Councillor has not acted in accordance with the standards set out in the Code of Conduct, you are able to make a complaint to the Kirklees Monitoring Officer.

The incident which has triggered the reason for your complaint must have taken place after 1st July 2012, when the new Code became effective.

Co-opted members with voting rights are also covered by the provisions of the Code of Conduct, but there are no co-opted members on the Parish Council at the present time.
