Members noted the rules covering community project grants.

Members noted the current year's budget and the finance statement dated 30<sup>th</sup> May 2013.

**CG5 Community  
Project Budget  
2013-14**

Members considered the application for £500 to contribute to the costs of holding the musical workshop on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2013 at the National Coal Mining Museum.

**CG6 Scissett Band**

It was noted that the application did not qualify for a community project grant due to the total project cost being below the minimum of £3,000 and also as it was a retrospective application.

Members considered if any other grant scheme was available to the Band, but as it was a retrospective application, it did not meet any of the rules.

**Recommendation:** That the Council rejects the application on the grounds that it is retrospective, which is not allowed under the rules of any grant scheme. Also that the Band is advised to apply for funding for future events before making any arrangements and/or bookings.

Members considered the application for £2,000 to contribute towards the costs of developing an existing overgrown garden area into a Sensory, Remembrance and Reflection garden.

**CG7 Shelley First  
School**
