The following personal interests were declared: Cllr B Armer in the Yetton Together application as he knows the treasurer of the group; Cllr J Paxton in the Flockton Forward and the Flockton Youth Group applications as he knows the applicants; Cllr R Thomas in the Kirkburton Church clock grant application as he knows the church signatory, the Kirkburton & Highburton Community Association application as he is a representative of the committee and the applications for Kirkburton Senior Football Club, Burton Out of School Club and Time Out as he knows the applicants.

Cllr S Beresford declared a disclosable pecuniary interest in the Lepton Highlanders application as he is a member of the club and left the meeting when the two applications were discussed and recommendations made.

Cllr R Edmunds declared a disclosable pecuniary interest in the Shepley Conservation Group and the Shepley Village Association as he is a member of both organisations. He left the meeting when those applications were discussed and the recommendations decided upon.

Members of Flockton Forward and Stocksmoor Village Hall Management Committee spoke in support of their grant applications.

Members considered the application from Flockton Forward for £6,400 to cover the costs of producing the architectural drawings and preliminary work in advance of the re-ordering of St James' the Great Church, Flockton. During the meeting it was disclosed that the funding for the architectural drawings and preliminary work had already been secured from a different source so the application was withdrawn from consideration at the present time.

Recommendation: To advise Flockton Forward to withdraw this application and to make a new application accompanied by the necessary supporting documentation, if funding is required for a different aspect of the project.

Members considered the application from Lepton Highlanders Cricket Club for £5,000 to contribute towards the costs of new nets.

Recommendation: That the Council awards a community project grant of £5,000 towards the costs of new nets.

Members considered the application from Stocksmoor Village Hall Management Committee for £1,546 to contribute towards the costs of new staging.

Small Annual Grants 2014/15 Cont'd

Cllr S Beresford left the meeting and the following item was chaired by Cllr J Paxton.

Members noted that the group had been formed as a result of merging Lepton Highlanders Junior Boys FC and Lepton Highlanders Junior Girls FC, and that the two groups had already received £700 in the applications made in 2012 and 2011.

CG18 Lepton Highlanders Junior Football Club

Recommendation: That Lepton Junior Football Club is awarded £50 as an annual small grant.

Recommendation: That the Management & Finance Committee considers the making a policy for this eventuality when it next reviews the rules, and awards the Club the difference if the policy would have resulted in a larger amount.

Cllr S Beresford returned to the meeting and resumed the Chairman's duties.

Members noted that the small annual grant application from Grange Moor Miners Welfar Bowling Club had been received two weeks after the closing date.

CG19 Grange Moor Miners Welfare Bowling Club

Recommendation: That the application is rejected as it had been received too late.

The meeting then closed.
