Members noted that Shepley Badminton Club was not based in the Parish Council area and as such did not comply with the Rules & Criteria covering Small Annual Grants.

Members noted that Shepley Scout Council had made 3 applications under the sections of Beavers, Cubs and Scouts, but that those from the Beavers and the Scouts had been withdrawn.
