<p>Resolved: To hold the discussions on the appointments of a Project Manager for the Climate Action Day and Trainers in fruit tree pruning in private, as they could be future contracts.</p>	<p>ECC3</p>	<p>Admission of the Public</p>

<p>Members noted the draft proposal, which outlined how the event could be organised and possible activities. Discussion took place about the possibility of appointing a Project Manager to manage the whole project, the cost of which would be covered by sponsorship.</p>	<p>ECC4</p>	<p>Climate Action Day</p>
<p>Recommendation: That Cllr Knight will draw up an initial draft of the brief for the Project Manager for discussion at the next meeting. The possibility of sponsorship will be explored when there is an idea of the likely cost.</p>		
<p>Members noted the project and the paper circulated, which listed the majority of the sites where fruit trees had been planted. They discussed the practicalities of the workshops, noting in particular that different kinds of trees need to be pruned at different times of the year, so 2 different courses were required. <p>Recommendations: That the Council confirms the project on the following basis under a separate agenda item:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To hold 4 sessions: 2 in the winter and 2 in the spring • The first session to be held in January in Shelley and to appoint Green & Brown Freelance Environmental to facilitate the session on the terms and conditions notified. • To take a decision on the venues and arrangements after the first session has taken place. • To encourage attendance at the first session of people willing to share the skills learned with other community groups, and reduce the need for a paid Trainer in the future.
